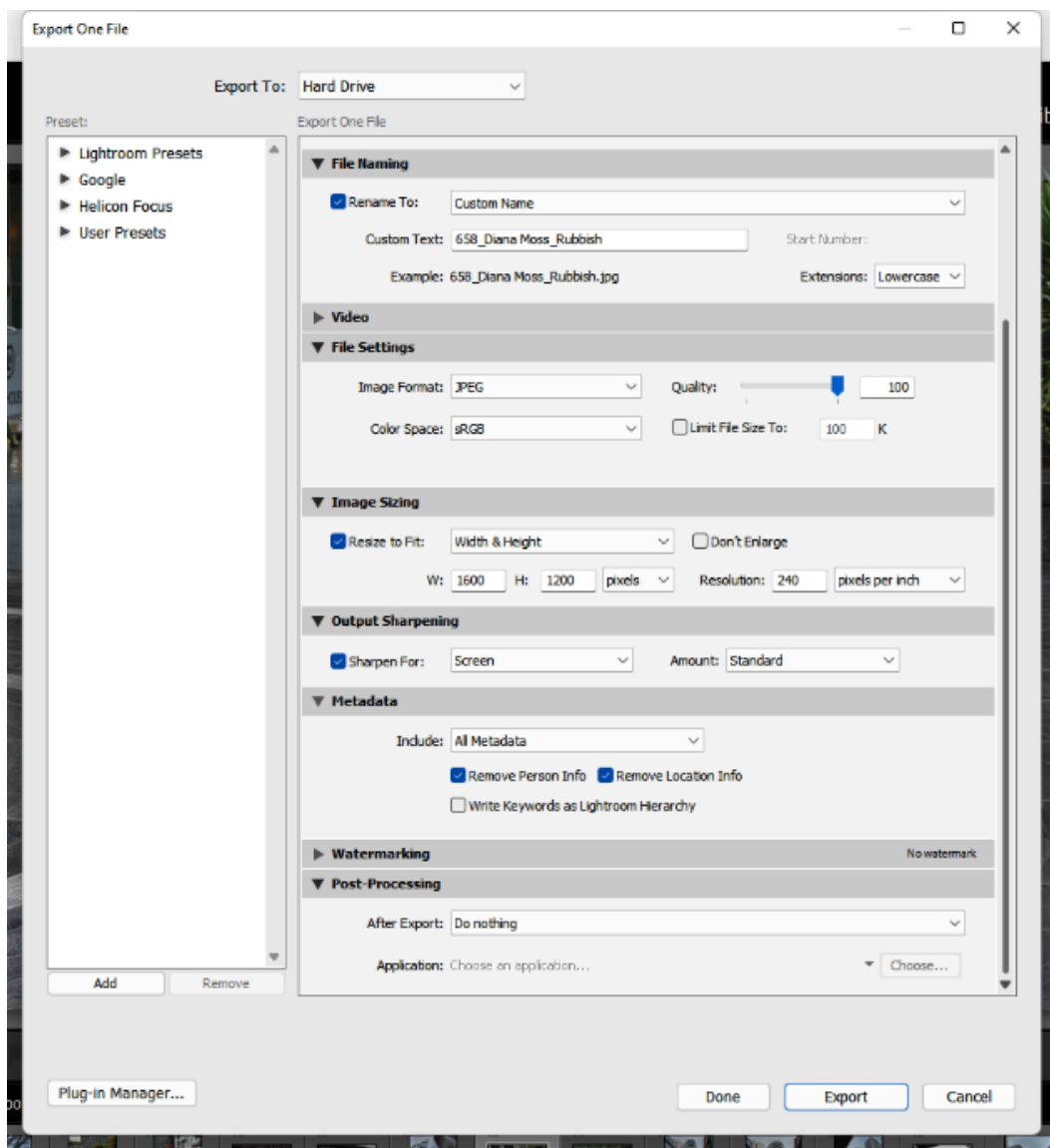


Using Lightroom to resize and name images for competitions

- Open Lightroom in Library mode
- Select an image to be resized and named
- Click on **Export** at the bottom lefthand side of page
- This will open a page which looks like the document below and separately attached



- Working down the page –
 - Export Location ‘Same folder as original photo’ there are other options but always somewhere it’s easy to find. I always put mine in Pictures folder.
 - File Naming – Important as the projection software only accepts a particular style.
 - ✓ Rename To
 - ✓ Select ‘Custom Name’

- ✓ Custom Text - Important, as this will help identify your image and it will be ready to upload to the website. The underscores are particularly important. The format is Member no. _Member Name_Title
e.g. 658_Diana Moss_Rhubarb
- Video (not Used)
- File Settings – Image format must be jpg. And Colour Space must be sRGB
- Image Sizing – Click 'Resize to Fit'
Enter 1600 for Width and 1200 for Height. Lightroom will resize Landscape or Portrait appropriately.
- Output Sharpening – Click 'Sharpen For' Screen. Standard Amount.
- Metadata – (not used)
- Watermarking – (not used)
- Post-Processing – After Export 'Do Nothing'

Right at the bottom of the page below my blue mark is the EXPORT button to click.
